



1. PERFORMANCE

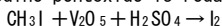
- 1) Measuring range : 0.4-8 ppm 1-20 ppm 2.5-50 ppm
Number of pump strokes : 2 (200mL) 1 (100mL) 1/2 (50mL)
- 2) Sampling time : 1.5 minutes/1 pump stroke
- 3) Detectable limit : 0.2 ppm (200mL)
- 4) Shelf life : 1 year
- 5) Operating temperature : 0 ~ 40°C
- 6) Temperature compensation : Necessary (See "TEMPERATURE CORRECTION TABLE")
- 7) Reading : Direct reading from the scale calibrated by 1 pump stroke
- 8) Colour change : White → Gray

2. RELATIVE STANDARD DEVIATION

RSD-low : 15% RSD-mid. : 10% RSD-high : 5%

3. CHEMICAL REACTION

Iodine pentoxide is reduced.

5. INTERFERENCE AND CROSS SENSITIVITY

(NOTE)

- 1) In case of 1/2 pump strokes, following formula is available for the actual concentration.
Actual concentration = 2.5 × Temperature corrected value
- 2) In case of 2 pump strokes, following formula is available for the actual concentration.
Actual concentration = 0.4 × Temperature corrected value

TEMPERATURE CORRECTION TABLE

Temperature : To correct for temperature, multiply the tube reading by the following factors.
